Chair Timm stated that a banner was made along with can cozies for Jones Park.

Chair Timm asked what should be included with the cozies.

Member Rehder said that a picture of Jones Park and the words, Jones Park, Coming Soon, rolled up and placed inside the cozies.

Chair Timm asked members to work shifts at the picnic.

The minutes of the April 30, 2014 meeting were not approved as they were not received.

On a motion by Clark/Dewey, carried on a voice vote, the Committee adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
