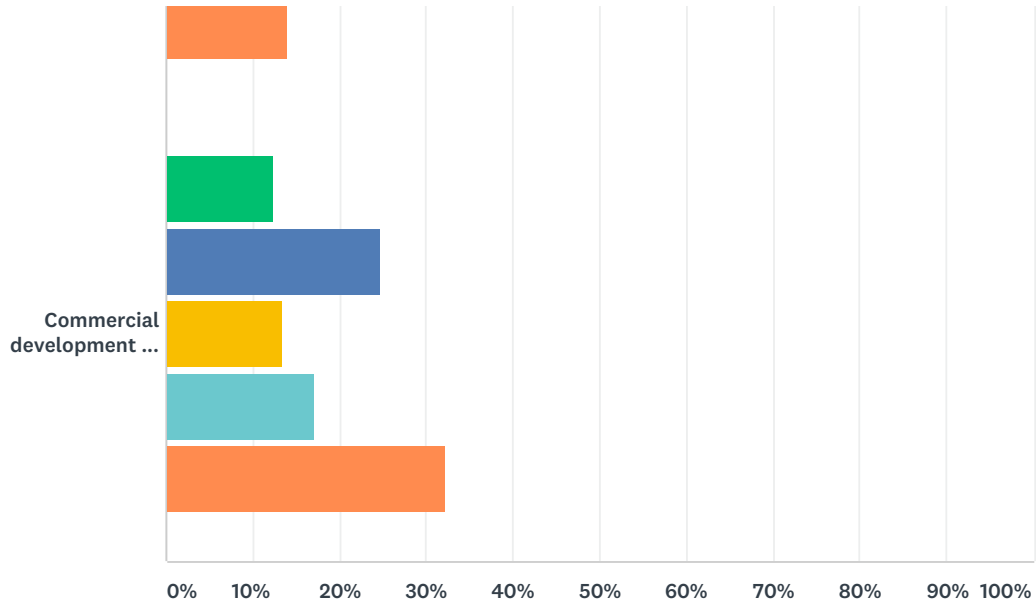

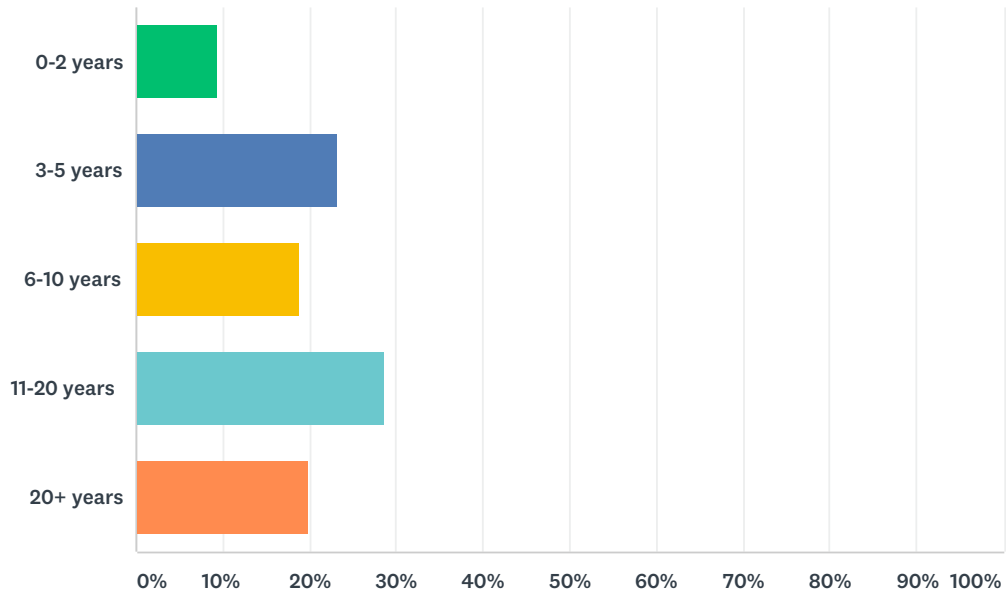

Q14 How long have you lived in the Town of Algoma?

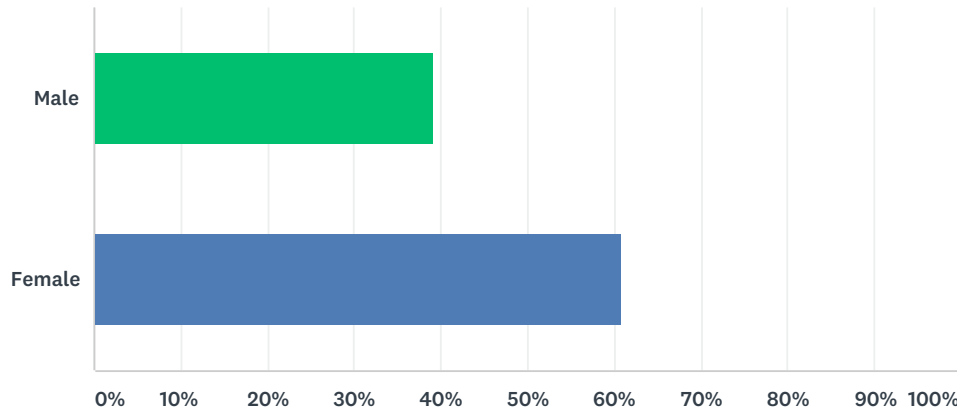

Q15 What is your gender?

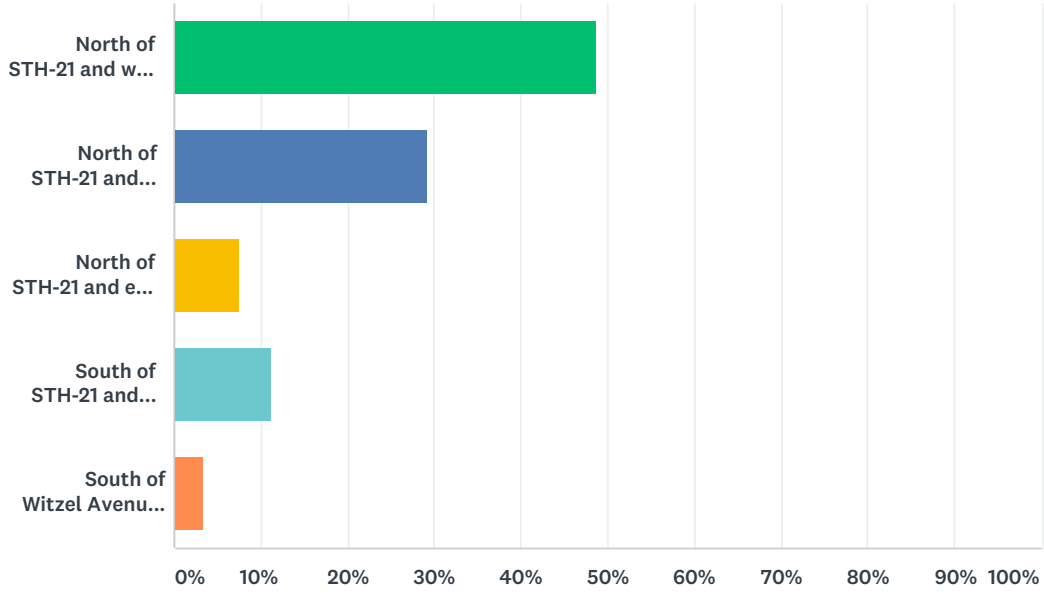
