The monthly Town Board meeting was called to order by Chair Rasmussen at 6:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all those present.

The following Supervisors were present: Christopher Wright, Patricia Frohrib, Joel Rasmussen, Patricia Clark and James Marvin.

The following were also present: Administrator Ben Krumenauer, Treasurer Sue Drexler and Clerk Deborah Stark.

Chair Rasmussen introduced the new Administrator, Ben Krumenauer.

On a motion by Clark/Wright, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the minutes of the Town Board meeting dated July 20, 2016.

On a motion by Frohrib/Clark, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the August 2016 disbursements with the notated changes.

No one came forward for the Public Forum.

The Fire Department provided a written report.

The Planning Commission did not have a meeting.

The Parks Committee discussed the rules and regulation for the parks and the Jones Park fundraising.

Administrator Ben Krumenauer reported the 2017 Budget is ready for a workshop. By consensus, the workshops will be held at 6:00 p.m. The Milwaukee Bucks are exploring the possibility of bringing a D-league team to the area. Krumenauer also reported that he is out meeting as many people as possible and looking at stormwater and drainage concerns on County E and Omro Road.

By consensus, the Board directed the Administrator to move forward with discussions with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation on several parcels that they currently own.

On a motion by Supervisors Wright/Clark, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the transfer of the Service Award Program Funds from Lincoln Benefit Life to MassMutual.

On a motion by Supervisors Clark/Frohrib, passed on a voice vote, the Board adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
