

**TOWN OF ALGOMA
WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN
September 15, 2021**

The monthly Town Board meeting was called to order by Chair Rasmussen at 6:00 p.m.

The following Supervisors were present: Daniel Martin, Teresa Van Aacken, Michael Brooks and Joel Rasmussen.

The following Supervisor was absent: Patricia Clark (excused).

The following were also present: Administrator Rich Heath and Clerk Deborah Stark.

It was noticed that the agenda was posted in three places on September 10, 2021.

On a motion by Supervisors Brooks/Martin, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the minutes of the Monthly Town Board Meeting dated August 18, 2021 with two corrections.

On a motion by Supervisors Martin/Van Aacken, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the September 2021 disbursements.

Faith Edwards of 3288 Creek Side Dr asked if the Town ever thought about doing Zoom meetings. Are citizens welcome at the budget workshops?

Sid Opperman of 4608 County Road E said that the person who was upset last month should have been treated differently. Winnebago County should be plowing the cul-de-sacs.

Karen Schmidt of 3127 Omro Rd said there has been no flooding since the Honey Creek culvert was connected. Would like to know what items are left to finish.

The Fire Department provided a written report. The new sign should be installed around November 4, 2021.

The Economic Development Committee did not meet.

The Planning Commission did not meet.

The Parks Committee did not meet.

The monthly financial statements were presented. The 'Bridge Loan' has been used for the Omro Road Construction payments.

Administrator Rich Heath reported that Irvine Pond is nearing completion. Tree planting, grading, seeding and matting is the next step. The seeding of native grasses and planting of aquatic plants will take place next summer. The State of Wisconsin will remove the temporary traffic signals around October 15, 2021. Supervisor Martin would like the Town to pass a resolution to keep the signals. Most of the curb and sidewalk from Oakwood School east has been poured and the first coat of asphalt has been laid. Along that same stretch many driveways, parking lots and side roads have also been finished. Honey Creek Road Culvert Replacement has had many weather delays, but is finally completed. The road will be paved when Omro Road is completed. The Leonard Point Rd Pedestrian Path has been completed. Signage and markings will be added later this month. The Town has asked Zillges Spa, Landscape and Fireplace for an estimate to complete some ditching on Addie Parkway. For the last two years, the Town has been seeking a person to fill the Road/Drainage Coordinator position. It has been a challenge to find someone with the skills needed to fill this part-time position. With sidewalks being added to Omro Road, the Town needs to have a snow and ice removal policy. The Board will be considering a first draft of the proposed policy.

On a motion by Chair Rasmussen/Supervisor Brooks, passed on a voice vote, the Board agreed to table the Snow and Ice Removal Policy until the regular October 2021 meeting.

On a motion by Supervisors Martin/Brooks, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the 2022 – 2024 contract with CliftonLarsonAllen LLP.

On a motion by Supervisors Martin/Van Aacken, passed on a voice vote, the Board approved the Operator License ending June 30, 2022 for Katie A Callies.

On a motion by Supervisors Van Aacken/Brooks, passed on a voice vote, the Board adjourned at 6:46 p.m.
