

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 01

**ORDINANCE TO ADD CHAPTER 340 ILLICIT DISCHARGE AND CONNECTION
TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ALGOMA,
WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Algoma, Winnebago County, Wisconsin is desirous to add Chapter 340 Illicit Discharge and Connection, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ALGOMA, WINNEBAGO COUNTY, WISCONSIN AS FOLLOWS:


Chapter 340 Illicit Discharge and Connection

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the health, safety, environment and general welfare of the citizens of Town of Algoma, Winnebago County, Wisconsin through the regulation of non-storm water discharges into waters of the state or the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to reduce pollutants to the maximum extent practicable as required by federal and state law. This ordinance establishes methods for controlling the introduction of pollutants into waters of the state or the MS4 in order to comply with requirements of the Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permit process. The objectives of this ordinance are:


- (a) To regulate the contribution of pollutants into waters of the state or the MS4 by storm water discharges by any user.
- (b) To prohibit illicit connections and discharges into waters of the state or the MS4.
- (c) To establish legal authority to carry out all inspection, surveillance, monitoring, and enforcement procedures necessary to ensure compliance with this ordinance.
